Washington, May 11.—The industrial commission today heard the first witness to be called in connection with the inquiry into the operation of trusts.

The witness was Hon. James W. Lee of Pittsburgh, attorney for several glass and oil companies and formerly a state senator of Pennsylvania.

Mr. Lee's testimony was devoted especially to the speaking of the trusts in the past, and he said that the trusts were organized to secure a monopoly and when this was secured by closing up rival establishments they were in position to fix prices which were, according to him, exorbitant, generally increased in order to permit distribution on a national basis.
