Claims Against the Government.

It will be remembered that in 1878 O. J. Hollister, collector of internal revenue for Utah, collected from a large number of assessments a tax on the strip used by those institutions for the manufacture of tobacco. This was done under the opinion that the strip was leased and situated in violation of the United States mining laws, or rather that it was liable to be taxed under those laws. Mr. M. L. Wright, attorney for Hollister, brought suit against the government and collected the amount that had been collected from those who were liable.

J. W. D. Dickey, who conducted the case of the Provo Woolen Mills Co., tried at Salt Lake City, to collect further claimants in the trial, but no further suits were brought.

He has now filed a new suit, and the parties are numbered to collect the amount paid into the treasury of the United States. Although the claims are now liable to be taxed under the judge thinks they can be collected, and he has given his opinion that they have been adjusted and been remitted in favor of the plaintiffs. In order to make the amount of sufficient magnitude to cover the expenses that will necessarily arise to be incurred in pursuing the case, he has agreed to pay the taxes, and thereby will have entered into an agreement with the judge in this matter.

There are some 800000 names throughout the country who are entitled to collect the amount paid into the treasury, and the amount of the various taxes aggregate \$7,573,25. If interest at 10 per cent can also be collected the sum will be more than one million.
