Election Day in Chicago. CHICAGO, 5.—In spite of the pre-diction made by the Canadian pro-phet of a flood in Chicago to day the weather is bright, sunny and cool with no prospects of storm, the snow hanks are giving way. Ballots were deposited very lively this morning but there was considerable slacken-ing later in the day. At 1.30 this afternoon the prospects was for only about two-thirds of a full vote. This is considered unfavorable for This is considered unfavorable for the republican candidates for city and town offices. Both sides seem confident and the vote will probably confident and the vote will probably be close. Harrison, democratic can-didate for mayor was elected to the mayorality in '78 by about 5,000 ma-jority. The city was carried by the republicans last November by 5,000 majority. So that no lesson can be drawn from those proceedings, the republicans claim to have made great gains among the Irish and the demo-crats claim large German accessions.
