Scale of Retrenchment Submitted at the Meeting of the Council.

COMMITTEES' RECOMMENDATIONS.

The Change in Gravity Sewer Contract—Health Commissioner's Report—Miscellaneous.

There was a meeting of the City Council last night, and retrenchment was the watchword. All of the members were present, except Councilman and President MacFarland occupied the chair.

THE PROCEEDINGS.

Petitioners and communications were read and referred as follows:

From Morris, Hanson & Wilkerson, stating that up to date they had performed \$30,000 worth of work on the gravity sewer; that it was of cement was on schedule, and that another strike might possibly occur, which would prevent finishing the sewer, that they had ordered the full amount of cement necessary to complete it. In view of these facts the petitioners ask the Council to allow them \$10,000 balance due on the basis of \$30,000 work ever performed.

From O. H. Potts, calling attention to the cutting of the Hapson court upon the erecting of law ordinances and requesting that quit claim deeds be delivered to all those whose property was sold for delinquent taxes this year.

From Smith, they asking that he be not compelled to remove his fruit stand from the corner of North and East Temple streets. Committee on streets.

From James H. Haggerty and others asking permission to lay a flagging sidewalk in front of their property on North and East Temple streets.

From the Telephone company asking that they be permitted to use street poles instead of aqueduct in replacing payment. Board of public works and committee on streets with power to act.

From superintendent Griffin of the waterworks department, asking that the waterworks be placed on the basis of \$55 the allowed. Committee on waterworks.

From the board of education asking permission to use sewer conduits with the Grant and Quilley school buildings. Committee on sewers.

From the same petitioners asking permission to make water connections with extra heavy one-inch pipe. Committee on waterworks.

From H. W. Nelson and others asking permission to make water connections with the Grant and Quilley school buildings. Committee on sewers.
