The City Council met last night to consider the bill to amend the Constitution of the City of Salt Lake, which was introduced by Dr. J. C. Shortholder. The measure provides that all the members of the Legislature shall be paid \$1,000 each year, and that the Legislature shall be allowed to draw up a resolution charging the respect of the constitution.

Palmer offered the following as a substitute:

"Whereas the constituents of the gravity of the bill to amend the Constitution of the City of Salt Lake, which was introduced by Dr. J. C. Shortholder, do not approve of the same, therefore be it resolved by the City Council that the bill be referred to a special committee with the understanding it shall be rejected."
