The Military Ball. In the evening will be the first event of the kind held in the Territory, and the guests of the evening, the Commander in Chief of the Militia, Gen. John W. West, and Staff, accompanied by Gen. W. H. Parsons and officers of the Douglas, will arrive in special cars and aid in this first reception to the National Guard of Utah.

The Rifle Matches. These will take place between a number of the companies, during the intervals between dancing and other pastimes. Revolving targets courteously loaned by the commander of Fort Douglas for this occasion, will be placed on the Saltair shore.

The Music. General W. H. Parsons has generously loaned the services of the best band of the Territory, which, with Christian music, will bring forth a new National air, with the strains of the waltz, march and polka on the evening air, as floating through the corridors of the great Pavilion.
