MISS ANDERSON'S DECLINE TO SAY

Anything as to Her Love Affair.

New York, Jan. 3.-A cable

from New York says Mary Anderson

was interviewed by her correspond-

ent at the Hotel Mediterranean

today on the subject of her reported

engagement to young Savarino, of

New York. She, blushing, said:

"I am aware that reports of my

engagement have been published in

New York, but I must decline to

discuss the subject at present. Ap-

parently, however, I am to make a

recent incident. A lady, Mrs. An-

derman, who lived in the same

terrace, was going to be married in

London. Her husband, however, was

regularly brought to me. No, no,

getting angry, brought her in to me

and said: 'You had better

take him, too.'"

After this Mrs. Anderson showed

much reluctance that the reporter

should Savarino and asked him

whether he would verify the report-

ed engagement.

"I must decline to discuss the

matter for that at present, but

he said it with such an evident air

of satisfaction that he gave good

reason to believe that the engage-

ment was settled fact.

Later Mrs. Anderson was met on

the Promenade Anglaise and asked

either to deny or confirm the re-

port, but she merely declined to dis-

cuss the matter. Then she was

asked whether the statements by

the 'Agent' that she would ap-

pear at the wedding of the Duke

of Thessalon, New York, October
