

The Powers Discuss the Cretan Question in Earnest.

ALGERIA WILL NOT SPEND A CENT.

Don't Toss Up the Flag of the Island.

Paris, March 12.—(Copyrighted by Associated Press.) The following telegram was received from the French government:

"The powers, while united in principle, have not yet been able to reach a solution of the Cretan question. Proposals and objections are being exchanged freely."

The present drawn up by the committee in Crete is as follows:

First, blockade of the island of Crete.

Second, blockade of Piræus and other Greek ports.

Third, seizure by the fleet of the island of Crete.

Fourth, any Greek warships encountered are to be taken to the island of Crete and kept there.

Fifth, any Greek warships flying on any foreign warships are to be sunk and the crew to be considered a crew of pirates.

Sixth, any Greek torpedo boat encountered is to be fired at.

Seventh, any Greek warships are to be required to allow the crews of the island warships, each lower is to be taken to Crete or to the island of Crete.

Each of the foreign admirals telegraphed a copy of these proposals to the committee.

Germany immediately telegraphed the powers that she would accept the proposals, down to the seventh and would accept the eighth in principle, but had no intention of carrying it out.
