MARINE DISASTERS.

Bad Collision—The "Seyda" Dis-

abled—Schooner Sunk.

LONDON, Sept. 7.—The Allan line

steamer "Prussian" from Philadelphia,

on her way from Glasgow, in the Clyde

last night collided with and sunk the

steamer "Mentley," which was almost

cut in two. The "Prussian" was beached.

BROKE HER MAIN SHAFT.

NEW YORK, Sept. 7.—The Galon line

steamer "Seyda" left New York on Tues-

day with 25 s. s. cabin and 50 steerage

passengers bound for Liverpool.

The vessel was wrecked on the coast

rendering her nearly helpless.

She hoisted and Captain Cushing de-

clared about the ship and gave the

signal to be hoisted and started upon

his return, about 3 miles from the

coast, when 300 miles from Sandy

Hook, perceived the signals of

distress, and immediately started

to the rescue. He was accompanied

by a pilot boat, which was

alongside of her. She accompa-

nied the disabled steamer until noon

yesterday without incident. The

German steamer "Polonia," from

Hamburg, home in sight, and soon

reached the disabled steamer. The

hull was away from the "Polonia"

to the bow of the "Seyda" and made

fast. The "Seyda" was hoisted on

the pilot boat, then started for New

York. Last night the "Polonia" and

Lloyd steamer "Alder" was sighted, and

the pilot boat went off to her and

put the pilot on board. The "Alder"

arrived today, and Pilot Hawkins brought

the news of the "Seyda's" disaster.

The "Seyda" is thought, will reach

here tomorrow afternoon. The

"Polonia" passengers will be transferred

to the "Seyda" and will leave for

Quebec and Liverpool on Tuesday

next.

A SCHOONER SUNK.

WILMINGTON, Del., Sept. 7.—Special

dispatches report the sinking of the

steamer "Seyda" on the coast of

Mississippi Creek in a severe storm

this morning. The schooner "Alder"

was also sunk. The crew of the
