EASTERN.

Washington, 29.—On Thursday of next week the quarterly payment of pensions will begin at all the agencies throughout the country, which about \$8,000,000 will be disbursed.

THE WAGNET REPORT.

Washington, 29.—The Wagnet report recommends the prosecution of the Potomac Ferry Company, for employing unlicensed officers; also the prosecution of the captain and mate, for not having licenses holding that ignorance in this respect is no palliation. The certificate of the engineer is cancelled for engaging as a trader. The report states that the origin of the fire is shrouded in mystery.

The Nathan Murder.

New York, 29.—A few months after Irving, the self-confessed murderer of Nathan, was arrested for burglary, he and four of his associates committed another burglary, in the Brooklyn drug mill, when he was shot and captured by a night watchman, but escaped from jail cutting through a partition, and lowering himself to the ground. The murder of Nathan was committed on the 25th of July, 1871, and Irving, was arrested on the following day in Hoboken on another charge. The police authorities of this city say it is not likely that they will make any effort to get possession of Irving, as it is by no means certain that he could be convicted of any crime on his arrest, and they do not wish to incur one thousand in useless expense. Eight weeks ago the chief of police of San Francisco telegraphed here, that he had Irving in custody, and Irving himself informed Captain Kennedy, by letter, that he would come out to the formality of a requisition. The police, however, do not think Irving had the courage to commit the murder, and believe that he only confessed to the commission of the act so that he may get a free passage to New York, where his wife and children are living.

Excited.

San Francisco, 29.—Wm. Clark Campbell, a negro, to-day, excited the crime of murder, for killing Thomas Doyle, on the gallows in this city.

Severe Railroad Accident.

London, 29.—The Detroit and Milwaukee passenger train, this a.m., met with a terrible accident at a station several miles from here. The passenger engine broke down, and while standing on the track, a freight train crashed into two emigrants, killing two women and wounding, more or less severely, twenty more persons.

Dying.

Dover, N.H., 29.—It is reported to-day that John H. Hale is failing and cannot survive long. His daughter arrived from West Point yesterday, and is still confined to her house by illness, and is guarded by two policemen. The charges against him are being made. The examination of the accounts is said, shows a deficiency in money on deposit in the city banks to be \$102,000, and the deficiency in the board of education \$20,000.

Thirty-two Vessels Lost.—Chief Justice.

Boston, 29.—It is ascertained that thirty-two Gloucester vessels went ashore at Magdalen Island, in the gale of Sunday.

Examined and Committed.

St. Catharines, Ont., 29.—The Albany murderer, Lowenstein, was brought before Judge Lowder, today, to be charged with the murder of Weston. He pleaded not guilty. Detective Folk of New York, the district attorney of Albany, and a number of other witnesses were examined closely. The prisoner was committed to jail, and is being held to prove an alibi. The Judge considered the evidence strong enough to fully commit him for trial. He will be handed over to the U. S. as soon as the necessary papers can be got.

FOREIGN.

THE "GREAT" Dwindling—Weather Unfavorable to Crops.

London, 29.—The Times has an editorial the burden of which is that one of the finest crops of wheat ever possessed is being gradually closed to her, and her destitute millions are being starved. The United States is competing successfully for control of the iron trade in the West Indies, and the West Indies, and that this country, though it has contested under immense disadvantages, has beaten England in the contest. There was some agitation in financial and commercial circles to-day, in consequence of the new departure of the gold clique. This combination permitted outsiders to sell gold premium down to 115 1/2, without bidding, for the purpose of depressing the street on Thursday next.

After allowing the short time to become weak and demoralized, the premium was quickly run up to 115 1/2, with several large purchases of half a million each to be identified with the Jay Gould interest. It is now well known in Wall Street that this combination owns and controls about thirty millions of gold in various banks in the city, and it is in their power to advance and reduce the price at their pleasure.

B. H. Donnan, a stockholder in the A. and P. R. R., applied to-day for a permanent injunction to restrain the company from consolidating with the Pacific R. R., by taking a lease of the latter road, or by placing any money there.

The decision is not yet given.
