## WATERWORKS COMMISSION

City Council Preparing for Municipal Ownership and Management of Plant.

### EOCCLES FRANCHISE HELD UP.

Commissioners want Maps Filed—District Court—School Sanitation—Funeral of A. L. Howe.

Ogden, Sept. 22.—Ogden City is beginning to make preparations for the receiving of the Ogden waterworks system, which will be taken over on the first of the month. At the session of the city council yesterday the city attorney was instructed to draw an ordinance and present it at the next meeting providing for a board of five water commissioners to manage the system.

The committee composed of Humphreys, Peery and Austin, appointed at last meeting of the council reported that it would take 30 days to prepare the books relative to the conducting of the business. The committee recommended that the preparation of the books, the transferring of the account and the making out of bills for the water users be referred to the engineering committee with power to act. The recommendations of the committee were adopted.

After disposing of the question relative to the transfer of the waterworks, the council then passed a resolution instructing the city recorder to prepare the books relative to the telephone company. This was done through the paved district of the city must be placed in underground conduits before the end of the month. The bond given by the company insuring these improvements would be declared forfeited.

A resolution was also passed recommending the removal of the city stockade and rock pile on city hall square to property owned by the city on Twelfth street between Jefferson and Madison avenues.

The special committee appointed to investigate the conditions of the threatened damage to the sewer near the Weber river recommended that \$150 additional be appropriated if the residents of that vicinity would donate like amount in labor in building wing dams to turn the course of the river which threatened destruction to much property. The committee's recommendation was adopted.

The report of the secretary of the board of health showing 18 cases of scarlet fever, and 12 cases of typhoid fever, 17 of the total being confined to the State Industrial school, was approved by the board. Two weeks, amounting to \$2,348.29, were approved and the auditor instructed to draw the necessary warrants.

The treasurer's report showed a balance on hand at last report of \$16,250.39; total receipts of \$4,134.32; and special tax amounting to \$2,174.39 was referred to the finance committee.

The claim of Wm. Doyle, contractor, for partial estimates an concrete bridge over the Ogden river, amounting to \$1,000 was approved and ordered paid.

A number of bids for sidewalk construction were opened and referred.

that the board would have something to guide them in determining the line. While the members of the board have expressed themselves as being in favor of the franchise, they are loath to grant the franchise until they are positive that the proposed line will encroach upon the public roadway too much. The residents of Ogden valley are heartily in favor of the granting of the franchise, and are leaning much toward the development and progress of Ogden valley. Final action in the matter will be considered next Monday.

### SCHOOL SANITATION

Supt. Allison Issues Letter to Principals on Important Subject.

Ogden, Sept. 22.—Superintendent William Allison of the Ogden public schools has sent the following self-explanatory letter to all principals in each building.

"To Principals—The use of drinking cups has been entirely abandoned. According to medical authority the drinking cup is a source of much of the distribution of contagious diseases. A plumber will adjust the water taps in your buildings so that a continuous flow of water will be maintained at all times. Please do not allow the use of any drinking cups in or about your buildings.

It is hardly necessary to mention again that the use of penholders should not be taken up and redistributed. Let each child keep the pencil and penholder that is given him the first year. Children are in the habit of putting pencils and penholders in their mouths. You can readily see how dangerous the practice of taking up and distributing penholders and penholders may become.

Janitors should be instructed to use sawdust in sweeping, dampened with disinfectant, to destroy the responsibility for the sanitary and cleanly condition of the school buildings rests with the principals. Janitors are instructed to make a report in writing here. We will try and remedy such conditions.

I have arranged with Dr. Beatty of the state board of health to meet teachers and principals one day this week. He will discuss with us many of the things pertaining to school sanitation. I will let you know by telephone when he can come.
