It is not possible that any more troops will be dispatched before the end of the week. The Zetlandia is to be sent to the Philippines, but none of the other transports are in port. The China is not due here until May 20, and the other ships from the Northern Pacific are characteristically late. It is hoped that the Japanese will put under an American register if or when it is time before that fleet can be put in order.

It is thought here that the fleet that will be sent to the Philippines will be the Charleston after leaving Honolulu. They all carry coal enough to last for a month, but the Zetlandia is to Manila, while the Charleston, under its command, will not be able to go to Manila. The other transports do not wait for the result, they may be expected to arrive Manila about June 20.
