Populists Do Not Agree About the Endorsement of Bryan.

SEE ON A SUITABLE PLATTER.

The arrival of the delegations from the 600-plus convention sections by a walk.

Mr. Loring, July 15.—It becomes more and more evident each day, as far as the meeting of the Populists national convention draws near, that the members of that party will not give the endorsement of Bryan to President.

Letters from all parts of the country are pouring into the national committee headquarters, some condemning and some demanding the endorsement of the Democratic ticket, and everything indicates that there is a decided difference of opinion.

In the opinion of Populists here, the party is not in danger of splitting over the question, they express the hope,

however, that some definite plan of action agreeable to all can be carried out at the meeting.

Several committees here have started a campaign to get the Populist leaders to accept the coming of the two silver states, who enter the national convention.

Upon the course they will depend, in a measure, the action of the other sections following.

If the Populists come out openly for Bryan and the Chicago platform, the question may not make much of a stir.

Editor, Wm. H. Smith, General Secretary of Grand Party, N. C., announced the silver party of his state will not endorse Bryan for President.

He said: "I am quite sure Bryan will carry North Dakota, which he is indicated to do in the last election, and I am sure he will not be beaten in the next election."

TOWNS, KAN., July 15.—The section of the Kansas Protectionist party antagonistic to the faction headed by ex-Governor John P. St. John, met in state convention today to nominate presidential electors on a state basis, and to enact a state constitution.

The protectionists are allied to the National Protectionists, who recently nominated Joshua Chamberlain for President.

Perseverant Chairman Mont Williams, in the name of several smaller sections, advised the meeting that he was not a member of the party, and he was given a seat on the platform, and the first elected president of Mrs. Gough, John P. St. John and others.

The party was weak, of Mrs. Mary Elizabeth Lewis and Mr. Foster, being scarce.

Upon the resolution to nominate the protectionists as national presidential electors, it was voted to adjourn.

The protectionists are awaiting the outcome of the election, when they will decide whether to endorse the Bryan and the Chicago platform, or the Omaha platform instead of an endorsement of the Chicago declaration.

In discussing this problem, some of the Populists here are in favor of the endorsement of Bryan for President, Mr.

J. Bryan, who is a delegate-at-large to the American Protectionist convention from California, and also editor of the Populist of San Francisco, said:

"There may be some difficulty in getting the Populists to endorse Bryan, but I think there is more about what the Populists themselves will do. They will vote for Bryan if he is a man."

The fact that Bryan stands upon a Democratic platform, and is separated from a platform as was constructed at Chicago, is no disqualification. There is very little difference between the Omaha platform and the Chicago platform."

Mr. George Kenney, general organizer of the nationalization party with headquarters New York City, is here to attend his party's convention which convenes next week.

Populists here are for Bryan, said Mr. Kenney, "with right in New York, where the representatives of industry on one side and the middle classes and daily wage-earners on the other, and it is going to be better from our point of view to have a Bryan than a McKinley, sinking fast, indecisive, nervous."

Every time a goldie Democrat goes to McKinley in New York he leaves the way for two silver Republicans to come to Bryan in the West. Every time a Des silver Democrat goes to New York he replaces the goldie Democrats in the West and vice versa.
