SALT LAKE HIGH BEATS COLLEGE

Red and Black Win by a Score of 44 To 0 and Clinch the State Championship.

There is now no doubt where the state football championship among high schools belongs. It has been clinched by the Salt Lake high school eleven, the outcome coming clear when the Red and Black defeated All Hallows college Saturday afternoon on Cummings field by an overwhelming score of 44 to 0.

Though the score was one-sided the college boys put up a much stronger effort than heretofore, and in spite of defeat never lost heart and in spite of many plaudits given them, showed a sense of pride in their work.

Both teams were well supported by parents and fans waving on the parts of the field while hundreds of students from the Red and Black and spectators came to witness the game.

All Hallows had the ball but a short time during the game, during that time they made big gains in smashing the ball around ends. But for fumbling and poorly executed forward passes they would have kept the score down considerably. The high played a brilliant though careful game using a series of sharp changes and hairback cuts, seldom using the forward pass or on-the-spot.

It was expected that Stevens, the college coach, would accomplish a greater record for his team but unfortunately did not have a single chance to display his ability except in punting. Ramsey, for the high, had six times with a try, twice failing each attempt.

The Red and Black can up 18 points in the first half by line smashing tactics and a good run of 30 yards by Goodson. Wetherman also had an excellent run of 40 yards after a forward pass.

At times the college made good gains and got the ball on high territory but they were unable to get within striking distance of the goal. In the second half Wetherman made a 60-yard gain and Ramsey tried a drop kick but failed.

The college played a strong game and made many big gains but lost the ball at crucial moments.

The Red and Black continued their smashing tactics and within 12 minutes made three touchdowns. Every man on the high team played a good game, chief heroes, however, going to Goodson. The line-up was as follows:


