Newfoundland, which states that a

clause in the charter of the New York

unnoticed, provides that at the end

of the first twenty years the govern-

ment of Newfoundland has the right

of purchasing the line at a

reasonable price. The company

recently applied to the government

to have this clause rescinded, and

their petition was refused. The

company, however, has a right to

purchase the line at the cost of the

plant, without paying anything for

good will or other intangible prop-

erty. The receipt of this intelligence
