CHEYENNE,23.—From the best in formation obtainable, it is learned that the White River Utes went to Uintah, but remained only long enough to obtain their money and are returning to White River "fo trade." Meacham, Ute commis-sioner, allowed them to remain three days, but they refused to leave, hav-ing been at the White River over 'wo weeks. Many Utes are return-ing from Uintah and are hiding in the mountains about the post. Mea-cham oftered them wagons, plows and horses to work, which they re-fused. Chief Jack, who command-ed the Utes in the fight against. Thornburgh, in September, 1879, said to Meacham: "Utes no want farms. Utes go back to Colorado, White River, hunt buckskin; hear, tade buckskin on White River Utes no want wagons; wagons no good hunt buckskin."
