CHICAGO, May 1.-May-Day, with  
its demonstration of organized labor  
in behalf of the eight-hour work

in a great mood, and the demon-  
stration did not do so for the  
purpose of taking up strikes and  
picketing, but for the purpose of  
showing the power of organized  
labor. Thousands of the day

long. It occupied two hours in  
passing a given point and the num-  
ber of men in the line was estimated  
at about thirty-five thousand.

van of the eight-hour movement,  
led the demonstration. They had  
about 5000 men, including three  
assemblies of Knights of Labor. They  
were followed by three thousand  
men, mostly men of color.  
Then came delegations from the  
unions of printers, metal workers,  
and masons. These were followed  
by a large German Turner society,  
forming the second division. Next  
came the furniture workers, car-  
penters, masons, bricklayers, and  
other trades. The parade was
