AN ORDINANCE

In Relation to Opium Smoking

SECTION 1.—Be it Ordained by the City Council of Salt Lake City, That no person shall, within the limits of this city, keep or main-tain, or become an inmate of, or visit, or in any way contribute to, room where opium is smoked, or where persons assemble for the purpose of smoking opium, or inhaling the fumes of opium, or where opium is sold for such purposes.

SEC. 2.—Any person who shall be found violating any of the provi-sions of the said Section of this Ordinance, shall be liable for a fine in any sum not less than ten dollars nor exceeding ninety-nine dollars, or by imprisonment for a period of not less than ten days nor more than one hundred days, in both fine and imprisonment.
