THE NEW DESERET PROCEEDINGS.

There is much comment over the attachment of certain pieces of private property which the Attorney General of the United States and the District Attorney of Utah claim to have been, at some time, the property of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. These are what is known as the Cannon house in this city, the James Jackson corner north of the Deseret News office and part of a lot adjoining the Jackson property on the east.

The report that the east half of the Temple block was also attached, proved to be a mistake, but there was a natural error arising from the claim of the Attorney General that only the west half of that block was except from seizure. This is a vital claim of forfeiture of the east half, but the order of attachment did not and could not, at present, include that piece of property, although the Government claims that it is forfeit under the law, so may be seen from the information filed in the District Court, the full text of which will be found in another column.

It cannot be supposed that this attachment decides anything in reference to that which is seized or to that which is claimed. It simply brings into litigation property now claimed to be subject to seizure which was not included in the attachment now pending in the United States court, now pending an appeal to the Supreme Court of the United States, was rendered. It makes some law and more, but the question of forfeiture of the east half of the Temple block, and the full confidence they claim in the ultimate triumph of justice and right. There is no need for excitement, and no cause for a single gloomy feeling, that is over all, into the law.
