FINE WHITE CELERY. - We, this morning, saw some very fine white celery, grown by Mr. Charles F. Williams, in the 4th Ward of this city. From root to crown it was about a yard long, and of corresponding girth. Mr. Williams has given considerable attention to the cultivation of this favorite plant, and has made a complete success of it. He has three thousand head of plants, and is now engaged in sending line samples of the home-grown article to every market in the Salt Lake market. Some of the sticks raised on his lot last year weighed seven pounds each, and were equal in diameter with a cauliflower and a gooseberry. The man had cauliflowers which weighed eleven pounds each, and gooseberries measuring seven inches round stem.
