## MUNICIPAL MATTERS

James Jennings Elected to Succeed Councilman Beale.

### DISPOSAL OF NEWARK DISCUSSED.

An Ordinance to be Drafted Committee. Railroads to Waigh Coal—Resolving Council will be Paid for Special Meetings.

At the regular session of the City Council last evening the order of business was discussed quite freely, and James Jennings was elected to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Councilman Beale. Honorable mention being made of the order of business, Jennings accepted a seat on the committee to handle Council business, while Councilmen—Beale, Callahan, Ditch, Le Prohon, Mulvey, Ramsey and Stewart familiarized themselves with the current topics affecting the welfare of our municipality. Business was transacted with in the regular order and came up as follows:

### PETITIONS AND ORDINANCES.

Arthur H. Mulvey asked permission to release lot 1, block 134, lot D, block Lake City survey, from tax sale. City attorney.

John A. Jacobs asked for a free license to peddle umbrellas. License committee.

Mary A. Jackson asked for release from tax sale on lots 13 and 14, block 4, of South Gate addition. City attorney.

County Clerk C. E. Stanton notified the Council of the county clerk's action in granting the use of a hall used by the Constitutional Convention, in the Utah militia, and asked for the city's concurrence, which was given. A communication was received from Watson and Miller, asking the Council to take gravel coming from the excavation on the old skating rink property at the price now given by the city, which is 15 cents per yard, graded.

The Green Creek Coal company asked permission to put in a well at the corner of Third West and Third South streets. Referred to the street committee and engineer with power to act.

Martin Olsen asked for a right of way upon city property in Mountain View to be used for private purposes. Granted.

WILL BUY THE CLOCK.

The committee on buildings and grounds recommended the payment of \$500 to John D. Park, the cost of the clock which has been in the council chamber for a year last past.

Young thought too much money had already been expended on time pieces, and favored retaining the clock and paying for the use of it. The committee report was finally adopted.

The auditor's claim of \$500, was recommended allowed by the special committee in which it had been referred, and as some discussion was brought up as to its validity it was referred to the city attorney.

Retain liquor license were granted to James Hagney and John Shaw.

JAMES JENNINGS WINS.

At this point of the proceedings Jennings asked that action be taken on the nomination made to fill the vacancy caused by Beale's resignation.

O'Brien hoped that the gentleman would not lose an action being taken. He had, at his home a picture from prominent Republicans of the Fourth precinct, asking that his picture, Mr. Jennings, to give the people, who he would act as a picture until he would have time to die.

### REPORTS OF CITY OFFICERS.

City Engineer Young notified the Council of the action in sending a small surveying party out to Utah Lake, located property under condemnation, and asked that the city reimburse him in the sum of \$100, which amount he had paid out as the expense of said party. Granted.

On recommendation of the street committee, H. P. Whittemore was granted permission to erect an electric wire across South Street from the Grand Hotel to the H. R. Knaplund hotel, to use transmission of an electric current.

The same committee recommended the granting of the petition of E. L. Johnston, in which he asks that the back street ordinance be enforced. On motion of Councilman Young the matter was referred back to the committee with a view to having the ordinance amended.

### TO DISPOSE OF THE NEWARK.

The sewer committee in reporting on the disposal of the sewer at the mouth of the gravelly sewer, recommended the building of a three-foot sewer conduit to carry the sewerage into the Jordan river, a distance of a mile and a half, at a cost of \$10,000.

O'Brien was afraid that the city could not afford such an expenditure, and wanted to refer the matter to a committee on the whole for discussion on Thursday evening.

The sewer committee had the subject under consideration for a good length of time. They had looked thoroughly into it, and said that the sewer was about to be put into operation, they had considered it high time to make a recommendation. A discussion was held on the subject, but was not time to have it. He then cited his reasons for the committee's recommendation and said that it was the only feasible way of disposing of the sewer.

Engineer Young spoke at some length on the subject, and in answer to the investigation made by Stewart McCracken, stated that an open ditch would be just as well, providing the town authority would permit such a ditch to be made for each property.

Councilman Young favored the proposition of a covered conduit and the sewer committee action should be immediately taken, so as to have the sewer in operation, before the close of the present Council's regime.

Other discussion was had on the matter and it was finally recommended to the sewer committee and they were authorized to confer with the Davis county officials with reference to the building of a covered conduit or open ditch.

The committee on public grounds recommended a lease on quarry land in Emigration canyon to Walter Perkins, at a rental of \$100 per year, and a quarter in advance. Adopted.

John P. Johnson's offer to sell the city certain land in Emigration canyon was rejected.

The Jordan canal and irrigation committee recommended the payment of \$10 to C. W. Perkins for damages to his property by overflow of canal. Adopted.

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CHURCH was not in favor of giving the money to be returned from Young.

### WILL REND THE SIDEWALKS.

The board of public works recommended that the street reported to be cracked to have sand sprinkled on the street, to prevent damage to the sidewalks.

PAY FOR SPECIAL MEETING. Council will pay for an extraordinary session of the city, if called by a vote taken on it. The matter was referred to the committee.

WILL WEIGH THEIR COAL. The following resolution offered by Hardy was adopted:

Resolved, That the city attorney draft an ordinance requiring the Union Pacific, the Oregon coast line and the U. S. R. R. to deliver to the city, at a specified place, a certain quantity of coal, to be used in the city, at a specified price.

OTHER RESOLUTIONS. A resolution by Mason providing for the holding of committee meetings on Friday evening of this week was adopted, as was a resolution authorizing the city engineer to open negotiations with the Utah Lake Sewerage company for the construction of the sewer which has so long been discussed.

LEASE APPROVED. The new lease giving to Barnes & Dwyer a five years' extension on the warm springs property was read and adopted and with the approval of the appropriations for the construction of the sewer, the bill was passed.

### THE MURDER OF C. R. HEATON.
