

RAWLINS GAINS ONE

Thatcher Lost One of His Original Supporters.

THE DEADLOCK STILL UNBROKEN

Rawlins' Highest Vote Reached Today - Henderson's Vote Lost.

At the noon meeting of the joint session today only two ballots were taken. On the first, the 40th to 43, J. Cook of Rich, voted for Thatcher, while the balance voted for Rawlins. In a numerous mood Rawlins won from Thatcher in Colfax, for whom the Republicans voted. There were no other changes from the last ballot of yesterday. The record stood:

At 2 o'clock the assembly met but adjourned without taking a ballot. The adjournment of Thatcher and Henderson combined to secure this result, exactly as in the last ballot of Rawlins.
