He followed the trails for some distance and smally came upon a came waspon and builty came upon a camp wagon and a buggy and farther away a horse dying of thirst.

Here was the starting point of a greater tragedy, for death was close on the heels of the delvers of these trages.

Following the trial further Kellogs read the tracks of a man and a woman and three children. Uneven and at times retreating and wavering in purpose, as though the travelers did not know which way to turn, the footprints on the send told of the search for water against a desperately growing seed. Sometimes the trail of one or the other of the children disappeared indicating Sometimes the trail of one or the other of the children disappeared indicating that the father or the mether had expended a last drop of energy in carrying their dying little ones. The trail followed the hed of a dry rreek for many miles and then led off to that country from which few travelers return.
