

Over this suspend a bucket of water, no matter how muddy, with a small hole in the bottom of the bucket, from which the water slowly trickles on to the cloth covering the top of the pot, and, in the course of an hour or so, you can draw off a tumbler of pure, celorless, bright sparkling, water. The water will also be much coolor than that in the bucket. If that in the bucket is very muddy the cloth on the top of the pot will need rins- ing about once a day. The materials in the filter will last a long time be- fore they will need cleaning or the charcoal renewing.
