Cut to Pieces, Hung and Burned at  
Midnight By Railway Men.

### THE FATE OF A BLACK SISTER.

The Criminal Court and the Grand  
Jury Take a Hand in the Matter.  
—Lynchers arrested.

**MURKIN, July 25.—**The jail of Shady county was broken into by several hundred men at midnight, and Leo Walker, a black man, was taken out and strung up to a telegraph pole. Afterwards his body was cremated.

The negro culprit was a native of south Mississippi and his name is history. He is among the most notorious criminals in the state.

Well over half a dozen men at the jail at that state gathered to wrench justice. The gates of the south wall of the massive structure were forced with a bar of railway iron used as a battering ram so the shambles outside the iron door was broken through with a club within the jail door or he tried to keep the mob out of the door. None of the mob was masked, and they seemed to be mainly railway workers. They had made a mad dash, and, with the gate open, the mob got inside and were soon from his body as he was with the mob. He was naked and skinned like a wild animal.

The night was a ghastly one.

At 6 o'clock this morning his mortal remains were only ashes among the embers of the funeral pyre from which he had been destroyed.

#### LYNCHERS ARRESTED.

**MURKIN, Texas, July 25.—**The aftermath of the lynching of Walker promises to be interesting. In the criminal court today Attorney Peters filed an affidavit certifying the manner in which the mob had been lawfully called to do their duty. The criminal court suspended the sheriff and the grand jury have been called to investigate the case. Several men, suspected of complicity in the lynching, have been arrested.

The governing committee has called that all to go to the convention, and that provided for by its constitution will be deemed a violation of the rules, punishable by expulsion."
