It is stated that more arrests would have been made today, but at the time the deputy sheriffs closed in on the betting ring all of the members of the Central association with the exception of one, were watching the Delmar race track. The sheriff's office, however, did not return to the ring.

The officials of the Delmar track, who announced that the action of the county officials will not interfere with the racing program for tomorrow, but it is doubtful if an attempt will be made by the members of the Central association to make wagers.

Jefferson City, Mo., June 26.—Governor Folk in an interview today, declared that either Missouri national guard or the St. Louis police department would be directed within the next twenty-four hours to raid the alleged bookmakers at Delmar race track.

The governor has discovered that action of the police and sheriff's office of the city of St. Louis the same powers in the Governor Folk's office.

St. Louis police board held a long conversation over the Delmar race track. The board decided that if the action of the sheriff's office was still in force a detail of police under command of Chief Kiley would be sent to arrest the alleged bookmakers.

If this plan is found inadvisable, then the governor will at once direct the adjutant-general to assemble a company of the state militia for immediate service in the county.

The militia of police, however, may be used to enforce the anti-betting law at all hours.
