

# MINING, BUSINESS AND STOCKS.

## MANY STAMPED TO LUCKY BOY CAMP

B. J. Areda Went from Chaffey and Are Now on Their Way Back—Opening Up Some Good Ore.

E. S. Chaffey, father of the city in Nevada that bears his name, trudged into Salt Lake City yesterday with his usual gold brick stored away in his grip. This time it weighed about 25 pounds, probable value of \$5,000, and represented a part of a ten and a half-days' run at the mill.

"The town is dead right now," said Mr. Chaffey. "There is a general strike on the Lucky Boy camp near Hawthorne. About 2,000 people looked into that camp and they are now going out pretty lively. It was one of the richest strikes ever made in Nevada, but it is not a poor man's camp. Men could not make anything unless they had money enough to sink 200 or 300 feet.

Chaffey the mines never looked better. The new custom mill is grinding out about 25 tons a day and several leasers are furnishing all the ore the mill can handle. Among those who are getting out ore are the Wheeler, Carter and Jackson leases on the Chaffey company's grounds, the Temple and Crocker lease on the old Auburn property and a number of others.

"The placer mines in Auburn canyon, I understand, have machinery installed and are getting some good values. Just the extent of what they have I do not know. They will soon get down to where they expect to get their high values."

"Edmunds and Murphy are pushing their placer work over in Barber canyon and they, too, are getting some values. It will be some time before they will be in running order, as I understand it."

### MARKETS SLOW DOWN.

Iron Blossom Again Given Trimming On Salt Lake Exchange.

The local stock markets slowed down considerably this morning and but few sales were registered on the Salt Lake exchange and no sales were made on the Utah exchange. On the former Iron Blossom appeared to be the prime mover and this stock came in for another trimming today. From \$14.75, the stock was carried down to \$13.50. The stock opened with one lot selling at the top price. From that the market gradually declined to the low price. It was weak, but the stock was close to 15,000 shares were dumped on the market at the morning session.

Colorado was slower again today and the price was weak. This stock was trimmed up and hammered down to \$24.25, just \$1 below what it sold at something over a month ago when it was believed that this property was to be taken over by the Colorado & Rio Grande. Columbus Consolidated was the only stock that showed a tendency to move up. In sympathy with Iron Blossom all other stocks on the board were weak.
