JESSE KNIGHT TO FIGHT CASE

Declares That Suit Against Colorado Company is a Hold Up.

NEW PAPERS IN EVIDENCE.

Statement Made That Wilson Sold His Holdings Seven Years Ago.

The big suit that has been brought against the Colorado Mining company by Joseph Wilson is attending no little amount of attention in mining circles. Contrary to all expectations, it has had a good effect on the stock, which has made a strong advance since the suit was filed. Many conjectures have been made as to the real strength of Mr. Wilson's claim against the company and the opinion has been about evenly divided.

KNIGHT DISCREDITS WILSON.

Uncle Jesse Knight, president of the Colorado company, is prepared to fight the suit to the last ditch. "It is worse than a holdup with a pistol," said Mr. Knight today, "and I don't care how strong you make that statement. It appears to be nothing more than a blackmailing scheme," he continued. "Several times Mr. Wilson has tried to compromise the matter. As there is nothing in the case, as far as the court is concerned, the case will be continued in the courts." Mr. Knight is much surprised that any attorney should consent to take the case, as no considers they have no case at all, and are only causing unnecessary trouble and expense.

MISSING PAPERS SHOW UP.

According to Mr. Knight, certain papers that were thought by the opposition to have disappeared, are really in possession of the Colorado company, being secured some two weeks ago. These papers concern the old mine, the gold standard and have a very important bearing on the case. Mr. Knight considers them invaluable and says they disprove every claim made by Mr. Wilson. He also says that he has conclusive evidence that Mr. Wilson disposed of all his holdings in the Colorado company some seven years ago.

Uncle Jesse is very sharp in his instructions over the whole affair and is prepared to fight the case from start to finish.

ON STOCK EXCHANGE.

Business Dull on Morning Call—Colorado Still Holds Firm.

There was a falling off in interest on the morning call and the volume of business was under the normal. Prices maintained a close average on yesterday's quotations and the general tone of the market was firm. Colorado held steadily at 1.40, while very little on the market. Black Jack and Seven Troughs were the only features to live up an otherwise dull session, both sold in considerable volume and closed steady.

No issues were recorded among the unlisted stocks. Standard Copper was held at 16 at 19. Ohio Copper at 2.50 at 2.60 and Ohio-Kentucky at 2.60 at 2.70.
