An American Missionary in India,

WATSONSBURG, D. C., Aug. 15.—The secretary of state has received a telegram from the United States chargé d'affaires at Constantinople informing him that the house of Dr. H. Hart, the American agent of Konki, Asia Minor, and the crew of his misadventures there were in danger. He believes if prompt action is not taken the house will be captured during the night. The burning of the building was originally stopped by the local authorities. Reference is made to the following news item: "A Turk who would not admit to himself that he would not make religious worship and instruct children on the premises. The American agent informed him that the treaty rights of Americans, extending not only to the purchase of land but to the enjoyment of same."

MINNEAPOLIS, Ida., Aug. 16.—The Republican State Convention convened on Saturday and proceeded to examine the ticket followed by the candidates. F. D. Willis, Cass County; Senator of State, J. F. Curtis, Ada County; Attorney-General, M. Parsons, Allerton County; Auditor, W. G. Ramsey, Blugham County; State treasurer, W. C. Hill, Superintendent of public instruction, and presidential elector, Judge Bissell, J. E. Watson, Jr., Atlanta.

The convention adjourned sine die, and adjourned this evening the following resolution: "Congratulating the Mormon Church on its recent restoration of abandoned polygamy and the rise of the church of Christ, we, the members of this convention, do hereby accept this declaration as ours, we pledge our pity, the continuance of the evidences of this restoration, and the restoration of the kingdom, restoring the full political power of Godliness secured to all others."

CALIFORNIA, Aug. 16.—Gen. Whitfield, leading the Free movement, said: "I subscribe the old-fashioned idea of constitutionalism for the white population, and I do not believe, therefore, that we will make many speeches outside of our state."

He said it was not good policy for the Free movement to be identified, and therefore a strong fight ought to be made in New York and other cities. Many prominent Republicans and their supporters replied: "We are bound to support Mr. Whitfield and his brother H. H. Kehall of the Free State at the Union Club where Genl. and Mrs. the editor of the Daily Tribune are. After Whitfield's speech he said: 'Xenia, Ohio, to visit his mother.'
