DISTRICT COURT ORDERS.

J. W. Groesbeck Discharged—Sunday Services—From Frost, McKinley.

Provo, Utah, June 10.—The following orders have been made in the Fourth district court:

Estate of John V. Smith, deceased; petition for final account and distribution ordered.

Estate and guardianship of Sophronia Smith, et al., minors; Julia Smith appointed guardian; bond \$2,000.

Estate and guardianship of Elizabeth A. Miller, a minor; petition to set aside order of appointment.

Estate of Jos. X. Thomas, deceased; order confirming sale of real estate and personal property.

Estate of Benjamin K. Bullock, deceased; petition for family allowance granted.

Estate and guardianship of Hannah B. Johnson, a minor; Hannah M. Johnson appointed guardian; bond \$400.

In the case of the Santaquin Mining company vs. the High Roller Mining company, Judge Marioneaux has handed down a decision directing that the complaint of plaintiff and the cross complaint of defendant be dismissed, and that neither party have or recover any costs in the proceedings.

Defendant has filed notice of intention to move the court to vacate and set aside the judgment.

Thomas R. Culey has commenced suit in Fourth district court against Walter Scott et al., to quiet title to certain parcels of land situated in sections 11 and 12, township 7 south, range 2 east, Salt Lake meridian in Utah county.

J. W. GROESBECK DISCHARGED.

In the case of the G. S. Wood Mercantile company vs. J. W. Groesbeck, wherein defendant was arrested as an absconding debtor, the order of arrest set for this morning was set aside on the grounds that the plaintiff had not been notified. Defendant, however, was brought before the court Judge Marioneaux presiding, on a writ of habeas corpus.

The defendant was represented by Messrs. Warner and Houtz who argued to the court that the writ was issued without authority or jurisdiction, claiming that the affidavit which was returned by Judge W. S. D. Helings did not contain sufficient facts to authorize an arrest. The court took the same view of the matter and ordered the discharge of defendant.

INFORMATION WANTED.

County Clerk Bachman has received a letter from an attorney in Detroit, Michigan, asking for information of two children of William H. Helings, who was divorced from his wife, Maria Helings, in this city, May 21, 1877.

Helings died lately in Detroit and his estate is being probated, hence the desire to locate the children. The records of the case show that the children were born in Passaic county, New Jersey, February 5, 1852, and that the divorce was granted on the grounds of desertion. Only one minor child, Ryma Turn Helings, then about 4 years of age, is mentioned in the complaint.

Defendant, the wife, who had possession of the child, but whose whereabouts at the time is not disclosed by the records. Judge Milner, who was attorney for Helings, is of the opinion that Mrs. Helings at that time was somewhere in the east, probably in New Jersey.

BACCALAUREATE ADDRESS.

Apostle Grant's Masterly Effort Highly Appreciated—Sad Accident.

Logan, Cache Co., June 9.—President James H. Linford presided at the baccalaureate services of the Brigham Young College held in the Logan Tabernacle today. There were present Apostle Heber J. Grant, Supt. of Church Schools J. M. Tanner, President John H. Lund, who had been engaged to deliver the sermon to the students, had been unexpectedly called away, Apostle Grant had come to fill the appointment.

Apostle Heber J. Grant began his address by speaking to the students on the importance of punctuality, citing incidents of great disasters happening by some one being a few minutes behind time. A director of a business concern is not appreciated if he is not punctual in attendance at meetings. Punctuality should be fixed in the habits of young people. The virtues of perseverance, self-effort and self-confidence were enlarged upon. The speaker dwelt on the importance of the student's qualifications will accomplish. "Be true to yourself and, as Shakespeare says, your can be false to no man. We should feel that there is nothing in the realm of human accomplishment, impossible for us to do." The speaker quoted from Lord Lytton as an example for the graduates, giving instances of the truth of the motto: "Dream nobly and manfully, and thy dream shall be accomplished."

One of the worst things in the sight of the Lord is idleness. Do not fear work. By doing a little more than is required, you will always have a chance for advancement, said the speaker. "I want to advise young people to be humble and prayerful. If you keep the commandments and are prayerful you will have a knowledge that this is the work of God. This was the aim of President Young in his last days, to prepare for the youth of Zion. 'Keep as far from danger as you can. When you are on the devil's ground the devil can pull you down.'"

Elder Grant referred to his forthcoming departure for the last of the Miko, and impressively bore testimony to the divinity of the Gospel.

The Apostle's sermon was a masterly effort, interesting and full of instruction to both young and old. Every serious student in the hall was listening to the sermon, and every member of the Church felt a renewal of his faith.

A double quartet under the leadership of Prof. G. W. Thatcher Jr., furnished the music for the occasion, and it was truly beautiful. Benediction was pronounced by President Joseph Morris.
