

M'CARTHY BEAT MOSE LA FONTISE.

Jerry Knocked Out His Opponent
In Less Than Ten
Rounds.

IS WELTERWEIGHT CHAMPION.

He Now Holds the Title for Utah and
Montana—Will Go After
Big Game.

Butte, Mont., Sept. 15.—Jerry McCarthy won the Montana welterweight championship from Mose Lafontise in the eighth round of what was to have been a twenty-round go by a knockout. In the seventh McCarthy knocked Lafontise down three times for the count, and in the eighth the Frenchman was tired and, though game, could not recover from the punishment he had received. A right swing by McCarthy failed to land with the glove, but as Lafontise ducked he caught the force of the blow on the back of the neck and went down and out. He staggered to his feet just after the count of 10, looking for more, but was taken to his corner by his seconds.

There was a long delay before the principals appeared in the ring and the fight was not over until midnight. A fair-sized crowd attended and about \$1,000 changed hands at the ring side. Mose was a shade the favorite, but tonight the betting was even. It was a fierce fight at both long and short range, both men fighting all the time. McCarthy landed repeatedly and covered well. Lafontise, looking for a chance to upset, left himself open many times, and this was the cause of his being.

Do you recall what we said in last evening's issue of the "News"?

It seems that Jerry was in pretty fair shape, thus enabling him to wallop his French rival into dreamland in less than 20 rounds. Jerry is one those boys who has to be worked quickly. He goes into action as if he were possessed. In attacking a contest he took the aggressive and proceeded to demonstrate to his friends here and in Butte that he is master of Lafontise in the game of astucious.

This makes two expert fighters. Jerry scored a knock-out and decision. Mose scored a knock-out and knockout.

At the time Lafontise beat Jerry, the latter was nothing but a big, strong husky lad, with absolutely no knowledge of the fighting game. Mose was, and is, an experienced fighter, and onto all the tricks in the game.

Jerry came home and by consistent steady work won the welter and middleweight championship of the state. The only check to his career was when he fought Stetson the first, and won, but lost the belt to him. But he went on and did the best he could to save his friend Kelley. He lost the decision, but in the next meeting between the pair, he whipped Stetson decisively.

His next engagement was a ten round go with Lafontise, and he beat the Frenchman in ten rounds. They were matched again, the battle being scheduled for Labor day, or rather night. The bout was postponed until last night. Lafontise was made favorite because he was considered to be the better man. The talent figured that he would be able to beat Jerry in a long distance journey. That is where Jerry made a mistake. The longer the battle went the better it was for Jerry. But it appears that Jerry is not to be beaten. He won the first fight, but lost the second, and in middle ground, in fact he earned the fight to him. In the seventh he foisted his old rival three times, and in the eighth laid him low with that terrible punch on the back of the neck—the punch Frank S. Lewis taught Jerry to use on the boxer he beat in the "Duke of the Man" on Queen street for about eight hours. It laid Lafontise low some weeks ago, and it put him to the scrap heap last night.

Jerry now proposes to go after the leading welters of the world. He is in line for the championship, and being a young, strong, rugged fellow, one who takes excellent care of himself, and with ever increasing cleverness, he stands a splendid chance to land at the top of the pugilistic ladder in the welterweight division of the game.
