Mr. Sim Tooker, the engine driver, whose eyes were so seriously injured by the boiler explosion on the C. P. R. R., the other day, has gone to Sacramento for medical treatment.

To See "The Folks."—The Legislature having adjourned until Monday, a number of the members of both houses, living in the adjacent settlements, seized the opportunity afforded by the brief respite from their labors, to take a run home this morning. Most of these will return to the city on Sunday evening.

Deseret Museum.—The curator respectfully acknowledges the receipt of a specimen of fibrous black oxide of iron, from the iron mines of Iron County. Also a piece of "Stikensides," both specimens presented by Thomas Taylor, Esq., of this city. Samples of home-made sugar, manufactured by Madson & Co., Gunnison, have been presented by Hon. C. W. Penrose.

City Council.—The City Council held a special session last evening, to consider the report of the Canal Committee. Two bills were presented and adopted by the Council; one relating to the purchase of a right of way for the canal, the other to the raising of funds for its construction, both of which are to be laid before the Legislative Assembly, next week.

Coming Entertainments.—The next attraction at the Theatre, is the second of the Carolee Orchestra Concerts, on the night of the 20th inst., a week from Monday next. "The Songster," a comic opera by Gilbert & Sullivan, (the authors of "Pinafore") which has been under rehearsal by Zion's Musical Society for several months, will be produced early in February. Shooting in Ogden.—Last night, about 10 o'clock, a shooting affray took place in Ogden, in which the two combatants, Sam. McMillan and Ed. Morton, were both badly wounded, the former, it is thought, fatally. The shooter, of Ogden, contains a full account of the affair. McMillan was in a house of ill-fame, at the time when Morton came to the door and the fight occurred right at the door of the house. McMillan received three balls, and at last accounts, was dying; Morton was also shot in two or three places, but not dangerously, and is under arrest.
