By Telegraph. Last Night's Dispatches. ELECTION RETURNS. LAKE CITY, Fla., 8.—The opinion of moderate men is that Florida will elect the entire democratic state by over 2,000 majority. The democratic gains are large in all the counties, with three or four exceptions. CHICAGO, 8.—A Journal's special from Cincinnati says there is a mere chance that North Carolina and Louisiana have gone republican. This information is derived from private dispatches to southerners now in Cincinnati. The latest returns from Wisconsin are that Hayes 1,601 majority; a net democratic gain of 776. The republicans claim the State by a small majority, but further returns will be necessary to determine the result. DES MOINES, 8.—Thirty counties have returned in the State give Hayes 21,940 majority, a gain over last year of 9,622. These counties cast about forty-five per cent of the vote of the State, similar gains in the remainder of the State will make Hayes majority from 55,000 to 60,000. She sends to the next House an unbroken force of ninety-four congressmen. The republicans here are greatly encouraged over the possible election of Hayes and are marching in the streets, singing patriotic songs, and are just now serenading the democrats assembled at the court house, by singing "John Brown's Body," etc. NEW YORK, 8.—Specials from Times state that South Carolina has gone republican by 10,000 majority, and Florida by an increased majority over 1875. The Tribune has a dispatch from Gov. Chamberlain, of South Carolina, claiming that State for the republicans by 15,000 majority. The Tribune's Florida specials give the State to the republicans. Both parties claim the election of Hayes by one majority. Intense excitement exists in all circles, and the streets in the vicinity of the news centres are almost impassable. The revised returns of the vote in this city show Tilden 111,950; Hayes 69,493; Tilden's majority 51,457. Cooper had 268. Montgomery, Ala., 8.—Further returns from the 14th District show that the contest is close between Hanson, colored, and Gen. Shelley, democrat. Shelley has made great gains. MILWAUKEE, 8.—Complete and partial returns of 41 counties show a net republican gain of 4,000; two hundred over last year. This cannot be overcome by the counties to be heard from. The republican majority in the State will be full 3,000. WASHINGTON, Del., 8.—The democratic majority in this State will reach 2,900. N. H., 8.—Returns from 210 towns give Hayes 99,644; Tilden 35,222, with 26 towns to hear from, which gave last year 70 democratic majority. The total vote will reach 80,000, the greatest ever polled. BOSTON, 8.—Returns from 332 towns, all but eight small ones, give Hayes 143,912; Tilden 105,535; Rice 131,480; Adams 108,020; Baker 11,868. The 7th District, complete, stands—Butler 12,600; Tarbox 9,425; How 2,028. TOPEKA, Kas., 8.—The returns are sufficient to show that Hayes carried the State by over 30,000 majority, and Anthony, republican Governor, by over 25,000. RALEIGH, N. C., 8.—Returns continue to come in, reporting heavy democratic gains from all quarters. The democratic majority in the State will hardly fall short of 15,000. The democrats elect all their congressmen except one, Governor Holden, who is elected in the 20th district. The legislature, which elects a United States Senator, is more than two-thirds democratic. CINCINNATI, 8.—The latest returns give Corbett, republican delegate, 1,000 majority. INDIANAPOLIS, 8.—Returns from 598 townships and wards which gave 48 per cent of the total vote, show Hayes ahead of Tilden 3,461, but this is a democratic gain. WHEELING, W. Va., 8.—This State will give about 17,000 majority for Tilden. All the three democratic congressmen are elected. EASTERN. A Republican Procession Visits Gov. Hayes. COLUMBUS, O., 8.—After hearing the news at the Republican headquarters, a crowd, numbering several thousands, formed in procession and marched to Gov. Hayes' residence. In response to repeated calls Gov. Hayes appeared in the doorway and, after deafening cheers, spoke as follows: "My friends—I assure you I am obliged for this hearty demonstration, but if you will keep quiet about a moment, I will say something which I think is my duty under the circumstances, to say, while our present advice look favorable, we must remember that several of the States, which have been considered doubtful, have a large territory remote from railroad or telegraph communication, and it will naturally take some time to receive definite returns from them. I, therefore, take this call as an earnest of your loyalty to the republican party and your desire for its success. If late advices should change the result from what it is announced at present, I assure you I shall frequently recall this visit during the time I shall yet live among you, with pleasure. LOUISVILLE, Ky., 8.—The excitement here over the general election has been most intense since last night. The streets are thronged with people, and eager and anxious masses are surrounding the newspaper offices to hear the latest returns. The streets are thronged and yet so far votes, to confirm Tilden's election, produce great interest and intensity. The returns from the presidential election, previous to now, show democratic gains almost everywhere. Mr. Henry Waterston is addressing a crowd before the Journal office, claiming Tilden's election certain with 200 electoral votes. In a Fever of Excitement—Government Employees Alarmed. WASHINGTON, 8.—Washington City is, to-night, in a fever of excitement, which has been continually growing in intensity since the receipt of the dispatches throwing some doubt upon the result of the presidential election, previous to that time the success of Tilden and Hendricks being almost universally conceded. Private manifestations of disappointment and gloomy dejection and alarm were very prevalent among the thousands of Government employees in the executive Department, before the afternoon reports inspired fresh hope among them, and in the minds of Washington republicans generally, and have had the effect of crowding the streets in the vicinity of all the news centres throughout the evening, until nearly midnight. Members of both parties were very pressious as to the doubt of the result, while patiently, though with intense anxiety, awaiting further returns. A General Outbreak Between the Blacks and Whites—One Killed and Several Wounded. CHARLESTON, S. C., 8.—The republican and democratic commissions are still widely at variance as to the result of the election. The former claim 8,000 majority for Chamberlain, but without the details of their estimate. The latter, conceding every county vote except about one hundred, according to the republican predictions, claim that Hampton is certainly elected. A serious riot broke out here about dusk in the evening on Broad Street. From the Court House to the Postoffice was crowded with blacks and whites all excited, and the blacks, much incensed at the returns unfavorable to the republicans, an altercation between a democrat and a republican took place, which was followed by a general outbreak of blacks, who in larger numbers than the whites, who opened a general fire with pistols and rifles upon the whites. The whites soon rallied, and sharp firing occurred. Intense excitement reigned throughout the city for some hours, and the companies of the United States troops in this city hastened quickly to the scene and dispersed the crowd, and now have charge of the street. The casualties are one negro mortally wounded and eight others seriously. One white, a son of Geo. Walden, a merchant, was killed, and about a dozen whites wounded. FOREIGN. FRANCE. The Japanese Attack the Insurgents. PARIS, 8.—A telegram from Japan, dated Nov. 6th, says that the Japanese naval and military forces have defeated the insurgent forces at Hagi, in the province of Nagato. The insurgents were beaten and fled. GREAT BRITAIN. Increase of the Durability of Iron Rails. LEIPS, 8.—The Mercury says experiments are being made with a process for increasing the durability of iron rails, which is the greatest success. An eminent railroad official has asserted confidently that, by this process, iron rails can be produced more durable than steel at an increase in cost of only \$5.00 per ton over the ordinary iron rails. Gordon, the African Explorer. LONDON, 8.—The press association is informed that the African explorer, Gordon, intends to continue his explorations in consequence of having discovered a branch of the White Nile which may possibly enable him to avoid the difficulties which have hitherto retarded his progress, and open a water communication from Victoria Nyanza to Khartoum. The Eastern Question. A Paris dispatch says intelligence has been received here that Elliot, the British ambassador in Constantinople, will communicate to the Porte the English proposals relative to the conference. The proposals are one negro treaty to enable either Russia or Turkey to make counter proposals. The Porte will not reply until it knows the views of the reply of the great Powers. It is believed that France and Italy will maintain reserve until aware of Russia's views. Austria has officially announced her intention to await the answer of the other Powers. The Russian answer will probably not be known until the Czar arrives at St. Petersburg. The London Press Favorable to Tilden's Election. The papers accept Tilden's election as a fixed fact, and comment favorably upon the event, expressing the opinion that the credit of the United States will be unimpaired, and that Tilden will govern the country satisfactorily and execute the duties of his office satisfactorily to all sections. Shipment of Gold. American coin, to the amount of \$225,000, was withdrawn from the Bank yesterday for New York. Dead. Rev. Samuel D. Waddy, D.D., who was made president of the Wesleyan Methodist Conference in 1859, is dead. The Times on Tilden's Election. The Times elaborately reviews the difficulties which Mr. Tilden will have to encounter in consequence of the conflicting majorities in the Senate and House of Representatives, and also discusses the claims of various sections of the democratic party for office patronage. The same paper considers Gov. Tilden's precedents a guarantee against his yielding to the pressure of the Southern democrats in favor of reactionary measures; and, in any event, it is more obvious that there is no danger of his consenting to measures of inflation or repudiation. He, moreover, is too sagacious to modify his foreign policy for the contentment of the Irish democrats. There is no ground, whether from a financial or political point of view, for denying him the confidence of all Englishmen. We are bound to respect the clearly pronounced will of the American people, and we cannot consider it an unexcusable misfortune for the republicans, who are temporarily compelled to breathe the bracing air of opposition. WEST INDIES. High Rate of Foreign Gold and Silver Abolished. HAVANA, 8.—A decree has been issued abolishing immediately the high rate at which foreign gold and silver money was received here by the government.
