KILLED BY SPANISH SHIPLERS.

The Report of General General Lee Im-
mediately Available—Norge Makes
a Statement.

NEXT YEAR, June 22.—The World
says:—The American three-masted
steamer *Hobart* of Rockland,
Maine, which has just arrived in the
Portuguese port of Funchal, made
the following news of fresh atrocities
by Spanish troops in Cuba. The
Spanish rebellion days are over, on
the north coast of Cuba and in
