

HUNDREDS OF JAPANESE
COMING IN SURREPTITIOUSLY

Washington, April 3.—Information has reached the immigration bureau of the department of commerce and labor that hundreds of Japanese have arrived in Mexico destined for the United States. Inspector Braun, who was sent to Mexico to investigate, telegraphed today that he had interviewed several hundred Japanese, principally laborers, who now are in Mexico. Many of them

are in straitened circumstances. They have no intention of remaining in Mexico, but desire to come to the United States. They expect to obtain employment on the railroads of the west and southwest. Some of them have already applied for admission to the United States and have been denied.

In every instance the immigrants hold passports issued to them by the Japanese government to Mexico. They tell the American officials that the Japanese government will not issue passports to the United States. In the cir-

cumstances, the Japanese cannot be admitted legally to this country, but scores are being smuggled across the Mexican border.

The department also is informed that many Japanese are reaching Honolulu. There they take passage to San Francisco, bearing passports to British Columbia. From San Francisco they go to Vancouver. It is known they have no business in Vancouver, but intend to make their way across the northern border to the United States. The general situation is regarded as serious by the immigration officials, for it prac-

tically is impossible to prevent smuggling across the border of either Mexico or British Columbia.

BREWERY STRIKE OVER.

St. Louis, April 3.—Contracts for three years were signed by the representatives of the various brewers and the striking employees, and the strike was officially declared terminated. There was a deadlock for two hours before the contracts were signed, because the brewery proprietors insisted on the insertion of an arbitration clause in all

contracts and the strikers objected, but finally yielded. The increase in wages granted and the changes in hours go into effect immediately. Operations will be resumed in the breweries as usual tomorrow.

BURNED TO DEATH.

Mother and Four Children Perish in Tenement House Fire.
Passaic, N. J., April 3.—Mrs. Philo-

mena Setupe and her four children perished in a tenement house fire here today. Many women and children were taken down ladders by the firemen, but the Setupe family probably were suffocated. Their bodies were found in the ruins.

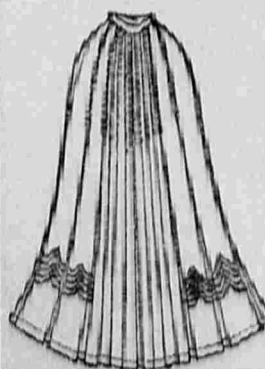
