

KAYSVILLE, Davis County, Feb. 24, 1886.

Editor Deseret News:

Having returned from a mission to the Southern States on the evening of the 1st instant, I am now ready to report my labors to the people of Salt Lake City to report my labors, I will give a sketch of them now.
