Salt Against a Blank.

T. A. Weston has instituted proceedings in the Third circuit court against the Denver National bank. He alleges that he deposited two sums of John Beck, one for \$100 and the other for \$300 in the bank, as collateral security for his son, now 20 years old, who is a student at the University of Denver. Beck died in 1885, before his note was due. Therefore he asks for the return of the Beck notes, having delivered the cash in payment of his own note when it fell due.

An Abstract of Judgment.
