CONGRESS YESTERDAY.

The House Holds Two Legislative Sessions in One Day.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 28.—In the House, McKinley, from the committee on rules, reported a resolution providing that tomorrow the House shall meet at 10 o'clock and immediately proceed to the consideration of the shipping bill, general debate to close at 4 o'clock. Friday the House shall meet at 10 o'clock and proceed to the consideration of the bill by paragraph, the previous question to be considered as ordered at 3 o'clock.

McKinley (Cal.) protested against this method of doing business, but said that, as a member of the committee on rules, he had agreed to the resolution, with a view of getting as much opportunity of debate as possible. It was the best the majority members could make out of the situation.

McMillan (Cal.), and other minority members of the committee on rules, took the same position. He then investigated against the vote of rules and asked that the bill be read in the beginning of Congress. He had said that.
