SENATOR BOGGS'S SUCCESSOR.

ST. LOUIS, 29.—Col. David H. Armstrong, an old citizen of St. Louis, who was elected to the Senate for the State for the past twenty-five or thirty years, was appointed United States Senator this evening by Governor Phelps to fill the vacancy caused by the death of Louis V. Boggs. Col. Armstrong is at present vice-president of the board of police commissioners of this city.
