GOOD ROADS ENTERPRISE.

Tax Proposition for Improvement of County Roads Meeting Popular Favor.

March 1st Celebrated in Style at Plain City—Five Days for a Sheep Felt.

Yesterday County Commissioners Adams and Smith, with Clerk Hollingsworth went to Hooper and Kanerville in the interest of the special road tax which is anticipated levying in the various precincts throughout the county.

At the first place they were welcomed by about seventy-five people, the proposition was explained to the meeting and a vote taken which resulted unanimously in favor of the tax and the levy of \$100,000 was decided upon. The total value of Hooper is \$150,000, and if the tax is levied on April 2, it will mean \$75,000 to be expended on the Hooper thoroughfares, which will be a great benefit to the county. At Kanerville only a few people were present and they voted against the levying of the special tax. It is thought that the proposition will meet the general approval of the property owners of most of the precincts.
