EXPOSITION ECHOES.

Utah Wants the State Award of Space for Her Mineral Exhibit as Exhibit.

The World's Fair Commission had a meeting last evening in the commission rooms at the Continental Hotel.

A proposition was made to propose some special photographic views for the Utah exhibit. The photographer will be required by the commission to take the views from mining and cultural departments.

The chief of geology, ethnology and mineralogical departments, Dr. W. M. Brewster, who is associated with the commission, said he would not go forward with the plan unless the commission would give him a large amount of time to study the subject.

Dr. Brewster, the standard bearer of science, has agreed to teach a class in the art of mineralogy and to give the students a good deal of time to study the subject.
