## DEALS MADE LAST MONTH

March Sales on 'Change Amounted  
To \$868,913.37.

## FEBRUARY WAS OUTDONE

By Over \$200,000—Market Conditions  
Were Not the Best—Today's Trans-  
actions in the Pit.

When the secretary of the Salt Lake Stock exchange balanced up his books last night, it was found that during the month of March there was sold on the exchange a total of 1,033,622 shares which cost the investor a total of \$868,913.37. The totals did not compare favorably with those of the same month a year ago, when 2,954,87 shares transferred for \$1,570,365.05. The month passed with the market at times, in an unsettled condition. There was that sluggishness in evidence which comes along periodically. The investor displayed indifference. The trading done was confined largely to the investment stocks, not so much attention being paid to the speculative kind. The general range of prices was not so good this month as last; but a few pulled through in better shape.

### SHIPMENTS FROM TINTIC.

A Total of 4,02 Cars Forwarded Last Month.

Eureka, March 31.—The following is the sum total of shipments made from the state of the state, and assist the prospectors in bringing them to the attention of capital.
