War Notes.

CONSTANTINOPLE, Dec. 28.—Herr Von Radowitz, German ambassador, has officially informed Kiamel Pacha, president of the council of ministers, that Germany will give Austria active military support if Russia should prove victorious in the Balkan campaign.

SOFIA, Dec. 28.—The Sobranje at the recent sitting unanimously voted 22,000 francs for supplying Bulgarian troops.

THE ABYSSINIAN CAMPAIGN.

LONDON, Dec. 28.—Admiral from Massawa, says that the Italian troops are making rapid progress.

Every preparation is being made to meet the advancing Abyssinian forces. It is reported that Rosa Alata, over-landed the Italian troops in order to induce King John to advance.

One column of the Abyssinian troops, commanded by a son of the King, has arrived at Adowa. Another column under Ras Mikael has reached Adigra.

ROME, Dec. 28.—It is reported that in consequence of news from Massawa, the government has decided to dispatch reinforcements early in January.

THE STRIKE.

Latest from the Scene of the Trouble.

ST. LOUIS, Dec. 28.—The Reading Railroad strike here and at Labor here are still out and declare they will not return to work until their discharged associates at this place are reinstated.

Three train crews of non-union men are at work but there are thirty-five without work here.

The striking miners at Stafford Mills in this locality are all idle owing to the lack of transportation facilities.

The railroad men here have issued a declaration that the miners will go on a strike as soon as requested to do so.

Good order prevails among the strikers.

READING, Dec. 28.—The coal and freight trains by this morning was the first to pass through the strike.

VERY RE-ESTABLISHED.

On the main line by the Reading Railroad, up to noon to-day 22 empty coal trains passed through Reading from Port Richmond, 23 loaded trains from the coal regions.

FALL RIVER, Mass., Dec. 28.—The striking miners at Stafford Mills decided today to return to work to-morrow on a promise that the pay would be equal to the strike.

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 28.—There was a feeling of uncertainty in Port Richmond all day, and some of the strikers about going on a second strike.

Still, it appeared that some sort of an order had been forth, and at noon 300 coal handlers.

CHICAGO, Dec. 28.—At 1 o'clock last night the cold wave struck Chicago and before morning the mercury dropped 20 degrees.

At 5 o'clock this morning the thermometer registered 10 above and, though the sun's rays moderated the temperature during the morning, it is expected that during the day a still more decided drop will occur.

Chicago was the coldest city in the north reported from points northwest, was about 10 degrees below zero.

There is a blizzard raging at La Crosse, Wisconsin, with a heavy snowfall.

At 11 below zero, it is expected that by tomorrow the Mississippi River will be frozen.
