NO RIFLE RENDEZVOUS.

Utah Troops for Terry's Regiment Still Sentured Over the State.

GENERAL CANNON WAITING FOR ORDERS.

At Least Two Volunteers for Every Man Wanted—Request for Medical Examination Have May 10 This Week.

General Cannon said today that he had today as many volunteers for membership in the Utah troop of Terry's cavalry as were necessary. This condition will necessitate a waiting out process and the consequent postponement of the rifle rendezvous. Cannon has decided to go to the front as a rough rider and volunteer. General Cannon is anxious to have the medical examination take place here, but cannot do so until he gets authority for it. His authority has been limited to securing names. This has, as stated, been done, twice over. It is not likely that all who have offered will be required to go to Fort Hanks. Only those who know whether they will actually be accepted they will naturally be somewhat slow in taking such a step. It is to avoid this complication that General Cannon has undertaken to have examinations and re-examinations in Salt Lake.

Colonel Terry, who has been in Washington for some time, is now in Cheyenne, having arrived there yesterday, and General Cannon has telegraphed him for instructions. It is said to be forthcoming in a very short time. His regiment of cavalry will consist of one troop from Utah, one from Nevada, and one from Idaho, sent from Colorado and seven from Wyoming, twelve in all.
