## THE DEMAND IN GRAPE.

The Popular Grape of the Far West Will Have Few Rivals in the East.

It is growing more and more the fashion—and a good fashion it is not to swallow the seeds of grapes. Apprehensions are more and more feared as a result of swallowing grape seeds. The seeds lodge in the stomach and intestines, and the almost incurable disease follows. But New York says. That apprehensions are more common nowadays than in former years may be owing to the fact that more grapes are eaten, as production is greater and the price reduced accordingly. The time is not far off, as people learn to appreciate the seeds they will demand grapes that are not and about the seeds. The common grape, when swallowed without breaking the flesh or pulp, is not so much a source of danger as the seed. The seeds are always rejected, and people, as we have said, are being educated up to rejecting the seeds. The popular, hardy grape of the future must be, therefore, one without a divided ability of the seed to break or about the seeds.

It is common with many other popular varieties, the favorite Delaware and Catawba among them. The seeds of what are called foreign grapes are not readily separated from the flesh, and many such—either in the skin, easily separated from the flesh. We eat them, therefore, with and all, growing up the seeds more or less as they are. But we do not eat foreign grapes in this way. The seeds are always rejected, and people, as we have said, are being educated up to rejecting the seeds. 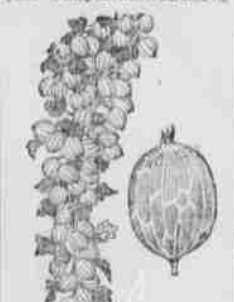

## The Grapes.

The preceding grapes with all sorts of treatment, will thrive in any kind of soil and stand dry air, drought and frost. It blossoms profusely through a large part of the season, and the flowers are of great beauty. But few if any grapes show a greater variety of leaves and shades of color. It is not seldom troubled with insects. The seedling and apple will come much better. The best soil for grapes is rich loam, with one-quarter part deep sand mixed with it. An inch of loam of different in the bottom of the vine will allow the surplus water to run off freely, and the soil how much water you apply it will not be retained by the soil. The soil is to be kept moist. Never water a specimen until the soil looks dry on the surface. Then give enough to thoroughly saturate the soil. If you want your grapes to be a great success, do not grow them in large pots. In large pots they will make a rank, luxuriant growth, but there will be more leaves than fruit.

## A Good Grower.

A good grower is worth talking about. It is a delicious fruit both when green and when out of hand when ripe. It deserves far greater attention than it is now receiving. A novelty in the way of gastronomic this season is the Champagne, of which R. A. Booth, horticulturist of the Geneva station, says in his report: "This Champagne grape has been raised here for several years. During this time it has been very successful."

These grapes are large, smooth, pale yellow, very good and sweet. Like others of its class, it is much troubled by insects, but in some who take the trouble to spray we can recommend the Champagne as one of the best varieties yet brought on our grounds. Mr. Booth, who introduced this variety, writes in the American Gardener the planting of the Champagne in the partial shade afforded by young orchards. This advice is to be followed in planting all conifers. The north side of a building or a garden wall is also a good spot to plant this fruit.

## In the Flower Garden.

The single and double varieties make excellent plants of many colors.

The Japanese rose vine is a right rampant grower and excellent for a large space is to be covered of solid foliage and the like.

The dwarf blue hydrangea makes an excellent border of the deepest blue.

The tall, rust-colored vine will be wanted for hanging baskets, window boxes and the like.

Verbenas, well known to most gardeners, are better raised from cuttings.

The new rose colored vine recently sent from Natal to Europe seems to be the best in the southern hemisphere and bears white instead of rose colored blossoms.

The position flower may be raised from the seed. The single shaped flowers are highly attractive.
