**POLICE.**—Mrs. Sarah Jones, of the Hot Springs, whose residence is known by a certain name, was taken before Justice Clinton to-day on three separate charges of selling liquor without license, selling liquor on Sunday, and keeping a house of assignation for purposes of prostitution. All the charges were fully sustained by the evidence and on the first she was fined \$50, the second \$25, and the third \$10. During the examination of a witness for the prosecution in the prostitution case, Mrs. Jones got excited, and, after having been warned by the court, she could not stand it any longer to hear him, jumped from her chair and made a sudden dash at him. A few words of timely admonition from the court, however, reduced her to a more peaceful state, and order was restored in the court. Justice was given by defendant's counsel on an appeal to a higher court, and the bonds were fixed at \$200 in each case.

"The hole in the wall" is said to have been a notorious resort for persons of loose morals for a considerable time past, and good and moral citizens will, doubtless, be pleased to learn that the city authorities have taken steps towards the abatement of the evil.

**MINUTES OF A CAUCUS HELD IN PARK CITY, JULY 20, 1872.**—Causes called to order by Mayor A. O. Smoot of Provo. On motion, W. N. Dusenberry was called to the chair, and I. M. Combs and C. D. Evans were appointed Secretaries.

On motion of Mayor Smoot a committee of eight was appointed to nominate candidates to fill the various offices at the August election. The committee was composed of the following gentlemen: County Nuttall, of Provo, chairman; Geo. Halliday, of Pleasant Grove; Z. Coltrin, of Fork; W. C. Koch, of Ogden; J. L. Simmons, of Payson; Robert T. Hill, of Newton; William Paxton, of American Fork; and C. D. Evans, of Springville. During the absence of the committee the caucus was addressed by Hon. George C. Cannon, W. Woodruff, Jos. F. Smith and A. O. Smoot.

The committee on nominations reported as follows:

Delegate to Congress, Geo. C. Cannon. Commissioners to locate University lands, John Van Cott, Z. S. Ellis and John Dusenberry. Representatives to Legislature, A. K. Thurber, W. B. Pace, Geo. Halliday, Selectman, H. J. McCullough. County Recorder, L. John Nuttall. County Treasurer, H. A. Dixon, Sheriff, H. C. Rogers. Coroner, Albert Johnson.

The above nominations were all sustained by unanimous vote.

On motion a committee of three was appointed in each precinct to see that the election was conducted strictly in accordance with law. W. N. Dusenberry, G. W. Bean and J. B. Milner, of Provo, were appointed to act as a central committee on this subject.

A motion was passed to have the proceedings of the caucus sent to the Deseret News and Salt Lake Herald for publication.

The caucus was attended by about three hundred gentlemen from all parts of the

country, and was characterized by good order, good feelings and a unanimity of sentiment rarely witnessed.
