BATTLESHIP FLEET SAILS FOR THE PACIFIC

Under Command of Rear-Admiral Robley D. Evans Passed Over the Virginia Capes Shortly After noon—Presidents Arrival on the Mayflower Signal for Thunderous Salutes—Officers Went Aboard and Paid Their Respects—Ships Passed in Single Column, Being 400 Yards Apart—The Connecticut is Flagship.

Cape Henry, Va., Dec. 16.—The president's yacht Mayflower, the dispatch boat Dolphin and the torpedo boats Stringham and Lindsey anchored together off the Horseshoe Tail of the Horseshoe. The fleet passed in review of the president, who was standing on the bridge of the Mayflower at 11:15 o'clock. The fleet passed out the Virginia capes shortly after noon.

Old Point Comfort, Va., Dec. 16.—The backbone of the American navy, 15 first class battleships, under command of Rear Admiral Robley D. Evans, set sail today for the Pacific ocean, on a 14,000 miles cruise, which will set all the world to talking.

Parading in review before the president or the United States and saluting as they went, the stately white vessels drew anchors from the rendezvous on Hampton Roads, steamed out of the famous old Virginia capes and were lost to view on the southern horizon, tiny tell-tale columns of black smoke behind; the last visible vestige of the departing fleet. At 10 knots speed they went, turning their backs on the coast which so long had been their home and headed for the western ocean.

It is the Mayflower had nearly reached the Old Point pier that the president had his first view of the splendid fleet.

On either side of a veritable marine boulevard the ships were disposed in two long lines, the flagship Connecticut and Minnesota, standing respectively at the head of the ship and on board the former. Like players at some giant game of "London Bridge," the twin battleships stood with figureheads overclassed waiting for the Mayflower to pass beneath and down the lane to meet the other ships which were paraded on opposite sides.

Each ship was gaily dressed from jackstaff to flagpost, the long lines of vari-colored signal battens fluttering in the early morning breeze first in an almost perpendicular rise from the stem to the signal yards surmounting the fore fighting top, then reaching straight back to the after top and down again to the stern rail of the quarter-deck. Black smoke pouring from every funnel indicated that the engineers forces were fulling up steam for the first step in the memorable voyage.

FLAGSHIP CONNECTICUT.—The Connecticut, flying the flag of Rear Admiral Evans, commanding the trip, was to speak to the president. Her captain and pilot were called upon alternately to proclaim their respect and duty to the nation's chief. Following the motion of the flagship, as it is expressed in the navy, the other ships took up the firing and in less than two minutes' time 336 guns had boomed. A play of mimic warfare by the finest fleet the American navy has ever boasted, and it gave a grand and spectacular effect. The smoke of battle soon swarming about the Mayflower.

PRESIDENT'S ARRIVAL.—President Roosevelt, accompanied by a party of guests, came down from Washington on the naval yacht Mayflower. His arrival in the harbor was signaled by a roar of salutes.

When the roar of the resulting powder had lifted from the deck of the Mayflower proceeded to anchor in the very center of the throbbing fleet. There followed a brief reception on board, the president having a talk with the four admirals and the commanding officer who were taking the ships through Magellan to San Francisco, on the conclusion of the meeting on the Mayflower's quarter deck. President Roosevelt shook each officer cordially by the hand and as they went over the side he bade them official

farewell.

SINGLE YACHT.—The fleet passed out in single column, the big government-built Connecticut, flagship of Admiral Evans, leading the way.

The vessels were 400 yards apart and in space of time there was the stretch of a decade between the 16,000 tons of the Connecticut to the little less than 11,000 of the Kentucky. Five stages of American battleship construction were represented in the line as an object lesson in the growth of the American navy, the spectacle of the naval review being a good luck had been uttered.

"GET UNDER WAY."

Suddenly the signal yards of the Connecticut flashed the message: "Get under way immediately following the motions of the flaggship."

Order followed from each vessel's bridge. They were conveyed by warning bell to engine room, through the musical notes of half a score of bugles and shrill voices of "one, two, three, four." Dressing lines were hauled in and as they tumbled to the decks the ships were robed of gaiety, attire.

A large number of yachts and excursion boats accompanied the fleet down the bay and gathered at the reviewing grounds.

PRESIDENT'S PARTY.—President Roosevelt's party on the Mayflower included Mrs. Roosevelt, Miss Ethel Roosevelt, the Astor, Mrs. George W. Nichols, Mrs. Newberry, Rear Admiral W. H. Brownson, chief of the Bureau of Navigation, and Mrs. Brownson, Rear Admiral and Mrs. Cowles and Commander and Mrs. Sims. The naval dispatch boat Dolphin also came from Washington with a party of congressmen on board to witness the review. The day of departure was fair and cool with an eight-mile breeze blowing from just a little to the south of west and ruffling the waters of the roared into sparkling bays.

At the time of the president's arrival the brilliant sun had set the bright and polished decks dancing in the rays.

The imaculate white hulls of the big fighting machines gleamed resplendently. Not a cloud decked the sky.

In the early morning scenes about the fleet anchorage were most picturesque.
