

## CHAMBER OF COMMERCE.

Proposition by Fred Simon in Relation to the Deseret Woolen Mills.

## THE TRANSPORTATION BUREAU.

is Executive Session which is Reported as Being Rather Livid and Stormy.

The special meeting of the Chamber of Commerce directors yesterday evening was an interesting one. The members present were President Hubbard, W. H. Ross, M. J. Gray, F. V. Keay, H. P. G. Coates, F. W. Madson, Elias Morris and Abraham H. Cannon.

Fred Simon made the following statement in relation to the Deseret Woolen Mills:

The company was incorporated for \$10,000, of which \$9,000 is paid in and is represented by the plant. Mr. Jennings is holding, in case of liquidation, the right to call in the amount paid in at \$10,000, and wishes to secure additional working capital to the amount of \$25,000, the whole to be merged, and the management to be vested in south mills.

They are in a minority, but we may have to take hold of it. We have been talking about commissioners, but here is an enterprise which actually exists, and the question is whether Salt Lake will be able to compete with Ogden for the manufacture of this class of goods. I see no reason why the development of this industry should not lead to the establishment of something more than a few good mills, but not equal in every way with those produced elsewhere, and I wish to say there is an excellent market for them. I ask that this be referred to a committee and that prompt action be taken to have a bill introduced to start the wheels moving on April 1.

The matter was referred to a committee consisting of A. H. Canute, Elias Morris and L. P. Keay, who next week will make a committee from the business men's association.

This is the third time that the committee has met to executive session and remained there until a late hour. It comes in a round-about way that the meeting was a stormy one.

An act of convention was introduced by the transportation bureau and the appointment of D. C. Adams as chairman of that body. These appointments were confirmed. D. C. ## HOW AND WHY IT WAS DONE.

The Report by the Committee on Markets, etc., on the Coal Inspectionship Accepted, Last Night.

The incipient sensation spring a few days ago on the matter of the city coal inspection was reported upon at the meeting of the Council last night by the committee on markets consisting of Moran, Rich and Evans. The committee said:

We, your committee on markets, beg leave to submit the following report in the matter of the inspection and certifying to the weighing of coal at the various coal yards in the city:

At December 3d last, your committee, in pursuance to instructions of the Council, took up the matter of sending three inspectors to the coal yards. A report to the Council was made recommending that inspectors be appointed until such time as the provisions of the ordinance relating to the master could be carried into effect. The master was referred back to the committee on markets. Your committee then decided to employ three inspectors for the principal yards. After examining fifteen or twenty applicants to their satisfaction, the following three were selected and appointed to the Master, and placed at the Union Pacific, Pleasant Valley and Etheridge yards. After further deliberation it was decided to place the whole management of the inspection in the hands of Mr. Barnet, a few days later, on Mr. Barnet's advice and recommendation, another Inspector was appointed at J. S. Morris & Son's yard. The other three yards (Witham, Old Allen and the Diamond) were left to be managed by Mr. Barnet, and the inspection was to be done by him. This system, though temporary, was the best year committee could devise, and it resulted in the approval of the Mayor. In a joint session of the Council, three yards were certified to be in accordance with the ordinance, one of which has met with any consideration by the Council, being laid over until the last session and then referred back.

As announced in last evening's news the City Council and county court held a joint session yesterday afternoon beginning at 4 o'clock, to discuss the question of reprimanding the joint city and county building.

For two hours the question was argued pro and con without arriving at any definite conclusion. Before adjournment the matter was referred back to the joint committee.

Your committee has not fully advised as to the benefits derived to the consumers by the system of operation, and we feel that no mistake has been made in inaugurating such a system. Every effort has been taken to cover every chance to do harm. Mr. Barnet can now begin a diligent and earnest to carrying out the institutions of your committee, and has at all times given you such information as was necessary.

We have examined the Inspector's reports, and find that if the city could collect the fees provided by the ordinance the expenses incurred by the power of attorney is amply covered.
