SATURDAY AFTERNOON.

After a recess of three hours, the Chamber was called to order at 2:30 and a resolution appropriating the sum of \$100,000 to be paid to the chief clerk of the Council and the chief clerk of the House...

At 4 p. m. the Governor announced the nomination of Geo. A. Lewis, Jr., of Chambers and James G. Thompson as his commissioners.

John Barrett, as territorial treasurer, was confirmed.

Evans moved to take the World's Fair bill from the table. McChesney moved the point of order that the bill was dead and could not be received...

At 5 p. m. the Governor announced that he had no further communication to make and wished these pleasant words to their families.

The House sent to the Council the appropriation bill.

Evans said he desired to say a few words before adjourning. He said that every member of the Council had endeavored to do what he believed to be the right thing.

The chamber pronounced the session and the faithful service of the Legislature closed.

At 6:30 Evans and Montgomery were adjourned as a committee to wait on the Governor.
