WASHINGTON NEWS.

WASHINGTON, 3d.—St. Outney,

French Minister, accompanied by the

Secretary of State, called upon the

President yesterday and presented

a translation of the following

letter from the President of the French

Republic, to the President of the

United States of America:

I have just received a letter

from your honorable predecessor,

his Excellency Rutherford B. Hayes,

announcing to me that in pursuance

of a resolution of Congress, he had

invited the government and people of

France to unite with the government

and people of the United States in

celebrating the one hundredth anni-

versary of the battle of Yorktown.

I have accepted the invitation in

the name of the Government of the

Republic and in that of the whole

French people. This solemn testi-

mony of remembrance, which has

been preserved by your fellow citi-

zens and by eminent citizens of

France, to the glorious struggle

which secured independence and

liberty to the United States, has

called forth a feeling of deep emo-

tion in France, of which it has af-

forded me the pleasure to inform

you by informing General Noyes, your

worthy representative that "having

taken part in the toil we would par-

ticipate in the honor."

The American people, who have been

powerful and prosperous, has by in-

volving our fraternal co-operation on

the occasion of this anniversary,

forever consecrated the Union which

was created by our alliance on the

battle field and which our institu-

tions now of the same character,

must draw closer for the welfare of

both nations.

Offering your assurance my high-

est esteem for yourself personally

and my best wishes for the glory of

the United States, I desire to ac-

knowledge my sincere thanks to Mr.

Hayes for the cordial feeling which

he expressed for the prosperity of

our Republic.

JULIUS GRENVY.

The Republican caucus committee

appointed to prepare a programme

for the proposed executive session,

have held several meetings, the last

one this afternoon, but have not yet

completed their labors and hardly

expect to till the caucus on Monday.

Five of the members, namely,

Dawes, Ingalls, Cameron, and

Boiling and Sewall, had a

conference with the President last

night and the complicated situation

was discussed at considerable length

with the view of returning, with

harmonious action on all points.

The committee informed the Pres-

ident that Senator Conkling had

given them the understanding that

nothing would be done for the con-

tinuation of the deadlock on his

account, but had

replied that, as far as the New York

caucus question was concerned,

he would not be a party to the

withdrawal of Judge Robertson's

nomination, which they earnestly

desired in the interests of party

harmony. The committee thereupon

asked the President whether it

would be embarrassing to him to

withdraw the nomination, and have

all the rest of the nominations

properly confirmed. President Gar-

field, in reply said with emphasis,

"No such proposition could be con-

sidered," and then the conference

ended.
